UPCOMING EVENTS

Holiday concert "Celebrate Peace" is Friday, December 7 at **7:30 PM** and Saturday, December 8 at **3 PM**.

Warm ups for both of these concerts will be in the Sanctuary – 1 hour prior to the concert. Family members will not be able to seat themselves early. It's important for choristers to be **fully uniformed and ready** at the call time! Please plan to arrive up to (no more than) 15 minutes before call time to get your pearls. On Saturday, Westminster Church hosts a Christmas Market and Bazaar, with a silent auction, lunch and a visit from St. Nicholas. Consider coming early to support our hosts and to enjoy the fun!

Concert Tickets: Individual tickets for the holiday concert at Westminster Church may be purchased in advance for \$6 general admission and \$7 reserved balcony seating. We will be offering a student/senior price of \$5 per ticket for any seats. Specify the concert/date/number of tickets you need and whether you would prefer balcony or main floor. Include your name and address and mail your check to SACC, 411 S. Washington, Spokane, WA 99204. Orders must be received no later than the Thursday prior to the concert.

Please check your calendars – Concert Choir will perform with the Singing Nuns – rehearsals on December 9 and 12, and performances on December 13 and 14. Concert Choir will also perform at First Night, with rehearsal on December 30, and performance on December 31.

Girls of Concert Choir – care of formal uniform.

Both the skirts and shirts are machine washable – delicate cycle and cold water.

DO NOT dry in dryer.

Lay flat to dry. Skirts can (and should) be ironed prior to performances.

Please make sure your uniform fits and is in good repair **prior** to concerts. Call time is not the time to figure this out!
